INTRODUCTION AND WELCOME

Welcome to the WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal!

To celebrate the 58th edition of the event organized by the Automóvel Club de Portugal, we have prepared a program full of exciting new features, designed to meet the expectations of the thousands of fans who follow us throughout the year.

The fifth round of the FIA World Rally Championship will take place in the North and Center regions of Portugal from May 15 to 18.

The operational base of the event remains at Exponor in Matosinhos, where rally headquarters, teams, and drivers will be based.

Following the Shakedown in Baltar, Paredes, the ceremonial start will once again be held in Coimbra, and the opening day will conclude with a Super Special Stage in Figueira da Foz.



On Friday, the rally will move to the Central region, featuring two runs through the classic stages of Lousã, Góis, Arganil, and Mortágua. Additionally, two new stages, Águeda/Sever do Vouga and Sever do Vouga/Albergaria-a--Velha, will debut at the WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal.

The excitement continues on Saturday with the rally's return to Vieira do Minho, followed by two runs through the Cabeceiras de Basto and Amarante stages. The day will end with a grand celebration at the newly refurbished Eurocircuito de Costilha in Lousada.

Sunday, the day of decisions, will feature the stages of Paredes, Felgueiras, and Fafe, with the final run of Fafe serving as the Power Stage.

The WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal counts internationally for the FIA World Rally Championship with Rally1 cars and for the WRC2 Championship with Rally2 cars.

We would like to extend our gratitude to all the municipalities involved in the event's itinerary: Águeda, Albergaria-a-Velha, Amarante, Arganil, Cabeceiras de Basto, Coimbra, Fafe, Felgueiras, Figueira da Foz, Góis, Lousã, Lousada, Matosinhos, Mortágua, Paredes, Sever do Vouga, and Vieira do Minho. Manufacturer teams, WRC teams, and FIA support Championships teams will benefit from the FIA recommended area. Remaining competitors will be attributed an area of 80m².

For additional space please refer to point 5.3.

WRC Teams will be able to access the Service Park from 09.00 a.m. on Saturday, 10th May, 2025. Should any team need to access the park before this or should they arrive at night, when normal access is closed, please contact the Rally Organisers, by e-mail <u>service.park@acp.pt</u> or call +351 963 929 021.

Service vehicles arriving at Service Park on Sunday, 11th May, in the morning, i.e., before teams have attended the administrative checks to get the corresponding documents and necessary vehicle plates, will be able to access the Park without a plate. From Tuesday, 13th May, at 09.00h, all vehicles will have to be duly identified with the corresponding plates. From that moment on, there will be an exhaustive control in order to guarantee that all vehicles parked or trying to access the Service Park carry the necessary plate.

Trailers are not allowed to park inside the Service Park.

Only vehicles with "SP - Service Park" plate will be authorised to stay inside the Service Park.

6 ON BOARD CAMERA (OBC) REGISTRATION

The competitor of any car which carries an on-board camera must have the prior agreement of the Promoter. Authorised cameras will be identified by an adhesive decal and must be mounted in the car at the time of scrutineering. The fixings of the camera and camera recorder must comply with the 2025 FIA International Sporting Code, Appendix J, Art.253.2.

Competitors wishing to use an on-board camera must apply via the WRC Accreditation Portal at least one week before the start of reconnaissance. Any requests presented after this date will not be considered therefore, the competitor will not be authorized to install an OBC on their car.

An authorization sticker, which must be affixed to the car in the vicinity of the authorized camera prior to Scrutineering, must be obtained from the HQ when collecting documents and other materials (Art 10.2). 9 IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

Competitors from the European Union do not need to make any special custom clearance for temporary import of cars and equipment for the purpose of participating in the 2025 Vodafone Rally de Portugal. Vehicles from outside the European Union must show their ATA (Admission Temporaire/Temporary Admission) carnet, which normally is applied for at the Chamber of Commerce in the country of origin.

10 HELICOPTERS

10.1 Registration Procedure

Complying to the requisites imposed by FIA on the safety and use of helicopters at the Rally, helicopters wishing to operate at the rally will have to register with the Organization. A protocol for controlling the restricted airspace over the SS's (Special Stages) prevents any unregistered helicopter of operating in that airspace. The registration fee for each helicopter is \notin 3000,00 +VAT. Registration deadline is the 10th of May 2025.

RALLY DE PORTUGAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY



ACP – Automóvel Club de Portugal, as organiser of WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal, is committed to the FIA Sustainability Programme and the FPAK Environmental Sustainability Code, with the aim of continuing to improve and minimise the environmental impact of the event and, as one of the WRC events that welcomes a large number of spectators, WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal maintains its aim of being a benchmark in environmental issues, both nationally and internationally.

According to FIA Environmental Accreditation Programme, WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal has been certified since 2017 with the Achievement of Excellence level and subsequently with the Three-Star Environmental Accreditation, the highest level of environmental sustainability recognition. In 2019, it was also recognised by the International Olympic Committee as the first motorsport success case for environmental sustainability.

To fulfil our objectives, we have established partnerships with Portuguese Environment Agency, all the municipalities involved in the event, environmental authorities and local waste management entities. We have also defined a programme to offset greenhouse gas emissions, and we promote actions to plant native species in the areas surrounding the event.

Therefore, WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal, through its Environmental Management System, will be guided by the following principles:

- Comply with applicable environmental legislation, as well as other obligations voluntarily assumed, including the FIA Environmental Accreditation Programme and the FPAK Environmental Sustainability Code;
- Inform and train everyone involved in the organisation about its environmental policy;
- Promote environmental awareness among our stakeholders (organisation, drivers, teams, volunteers, media, spectators, partners and external suppliers) and encourage them to fulfil and enforce good environmental practices;
- Take into account the environmental impact when choosing partners and suppliers, as well as in the process of selecting and purchasing products and services;
- Reduce the environmental impact in terms of transportation, as far as possible, encouraging carpooling and car sharing, as well as the use of public transport;
- Promote responsibility in preserving the environment by managing and monitoring the direct and indirect impacts of the event, in particular energy consumption and associated greenhouse gas emissions, water consumption and other natural resources, and proper waste management;
- Encourage adequate and proactive management of environmental risk, in particular pollution prevention and emergency response to accidents and/or disasters;
- Promote the continuous improvement of processes, practices and environmental developments by defining and evaluating progressively more ambitious environmental objectives.

This Environmental Policy, supported by a strong "performance against objectives" attitude, will regularly be reviewed and updated, ensuring continuous improvement of the entire Environmental Management System.
